Tournament Description

The tournament will consist of 3 Divisions based on skill level. Play will begin with round robin games in each division.

After the round robin games teams will be seeded for a double elimination tournament based on record to determine overall division championship.

There will also be a toilet bowl championship for each division.

Tournament Rules

- 1. A ball that touches any part of an opponents body and does not get caught (touches the floor or other inanimate object) by that player or a teammate is out.
- 2. A ball that hits the floor, ceiling, wall spectator, or any other stationary object in or out of the field of play is considered a dead ball.
- 3. A ball that hits another ball is in play until it hits the floor or another inanimate object.
- 4. Balls may be deflected by a ball that is held by a player without the player being out, however if the person deflecting the ball drops it, or gets hit on a ricochet they will be out.
- 5. A ball caught (directly or off deflection from a teammate or other ball) will result in the thrower being out and one out player from the catching team being able to re-enter the game.
- 6. A player who crosses the line (free throw line extended) before, after , or during a throw will be out.
- 7. Arguing a referee's call, swearing, or any form of cheating will not be tolerated and will result in disqualification of the individual or team from the game and/or tournament. If you are called out, you are out NO ARGUING!
- 8. We will be playing in a brand new gym so rubber soled Tennis shoes are required.
 - Each Team will be allowed one injury substitution after that you must play a man down.
